

Shipley (From Ian):

Feedback has been pretty good, from all concerned.

Only 12 on day entries which was rather low as was the entries.

It felt empty all day, which I didn't like. No atmosphere.

We cut all our costs back, the event needs a commentary.

Also noticed that those with campers and vans retired to or stayed at their vans rather than coming into the events field, which is a shame.

CM: Swindon CX had all the team gazebos together to create an atmosphere Actively encourage clubs to bring their own gazebos

NC: inc in race pack where club gazebos can go

TD: thought the atmosphere was OK but perhaps we could bring the course closer to

the spectator area

HPP was good, nice course, better numbers but we still want more.

4.2 How to assign Leaders Jersey (Caroline) - see separate Jersey Regs document

If the leader is there, the jersey is worn for racing

If the new series leader is missing the jersey does not get presented on the podium If there is a tie on points, the jersey is awarded on the results of the most recent race.

Stu: include league position and points on the gridding sheets

CC: the leader wearing the jersey for the EM Champs will therefore wear it at the end as they will get average points

ACTION remind people ahead of Regional Champs that they will get average

Calculating the series leader is done purely on points so far but this means that the series winner could change once dropped points are taken into account. Ideally this would be done at the final race but this means the results team and organiser needs to be ready to do that once the race finishes.

ACTION publicise last round leaders jersey will be awarded at the awards evening instead ACTION Mike to check dropped round and average point calculation

ACTION Mike to suggest rule amendment wording to make it clear that dropped rounds are not included in average score

4.3 Youth gridding (Comms)

I'm sure we can't please everyone but there were some queries as to why all the girls were set off with the U16 Open pack. The HPP Comm raised this with me after the event.

From Helen D: Feedback from 6 parents (I emailed all 12 after the HPP event).

3 girls would prefer to start in complete lines of girls preferable behind the U16 boys (from 2 of them)

1 girl doesn't mind if it's a few on each row or whole rows as long as they (all the girls) are together.

Other 2 girls are 'fairly flexible' They both like 2-3 girls per line but would like it to be with own age group boys. Consistency more important than what is decided from one of those girls.

Option 1 parallel gridding by age

Option 2 all girls gridded behind O16 but have a separate start

9-2 voted (2 abstained) in favour of option 2

4.4 Comms crib sheet to update (Andy H)

ACTION Andy to update the crib sheet to reflect the new youth gridding with three starts; the time gaps need to flexible

Vet Open races - make it clear that there are separate whistles for 40s and 50/60s Juniors/U23-Seniors Open races - one whistle, Seniors and U23s gridded together first and then the Juniors behind

ACTION: everyone think of creative ways of encouraging and creating content

4.6 Sustainability (Helen D)

Use brightly coloured rope (orange) for marking the course

Nick: need to be careful where rope is used, useful to have someone who doesn't know the course to ride it as they may have a different view of the course than those who set it up.

4.7 CX Commission update (Rob)

Tyre widths being reviewed given the increase of gravel optimised wheels

UCI approved frames will be enforced but we think for UCI races only

BC sending riders to the Worlds not Euros

Youth Champs in Slovakia this year as a side comment - clashes with Paignton and even further

Hope Super Cross event in 2025 wanting more support to have spectators and for local regions to keep the weekends free

Regional Champs: encouraged to go to their region; but can a rider outside of the EMs still race Markeaton?

Yes, but they will be gridded at the back and even if they win the race they will not win the EM trophy

Inter-regional competition proposed - 7th and 8th Dec at National Trophy Clanfield round

Event 1: The Long Race, Saturday Daytime

CYCLO-CROSS LEAGUE

The Trophy U16 youth races act as the first event for the regional teams. Riders compete in their respective races as normal (gridded as normal), competing in a regional jersey over their club kit. The cumulative times from the fastest three boys and three girls in each team represents the team result and give the teams total time. Total time is important as it acts as the handicap in the final team relay.

Event 2: The Sprint Race, Saturday Early Evening

A short course sprint event under floodlights. Approx. 2 min laps, one bike, no pits. Two mass start races for girls and boys. Fast and furious 10 - 15m races around the short course. Gridding based on finish positions in The Long Race. Average time for top three boys and the average time for top three girls in each team is added to the teams total time. All sort races completed within 60m from 1700-1800h, including course time.

Event 3: The Skills Challenge, Sunday Morning

An off-course skills test to acquire bonus seconds based on the rider level achieved. A broad set of potential skills announced and circulated to Team Managers in September, but the specific skill tests announced 1 week before. The skills test will be performed in under 1m (so we can complete the event within about 90m from 0930-1100h). Riders shall be given an optional second attempts, but if they do this, the second attempt counts whatever the outcome. Best three girls and three boys gather bonus seconds to be added to the teams total time.

Event 4: The Final. Team Relay, Sunday Lunchtime

Regional team relay, with six riders (min. 3 girls) racing half laps (TBA, if time permits full laps may work), using the pits as the changeover area. The start order is handicapped based on the current time standing, meaning the fastest team start first and the order across the finish line is the CXIR final result.
